Prelude

- Organ repertoire, selections at the discretion of the organist
- A contrasting program of joyful and meditative pieces will be selected, approximately 20 minutes in length.
- A specific piece or pieces may be requested, but is subject to the approval of the Director of Music. Please note that if requested pieces are approved and not in the organist's repertoire, an additional fee may be required.
- A trumpet or vocal (cantor soloist) piece may be played/sung as part of the prelude.
- Solos to be included in prelude and/or used for Seating of Mothers
